

WE CANNOT DISREGARD THE QUALITATIVE AND QUANTITATIVE CHANGE OF AC-TION UNDERTAKEN BY THE MAGISTRACY AND THE POLICE AGAINST THE PROLETA-RIAN MOVEMENTS AND THEIR ORGANIZATIONS. ALL THAT CAN BE USED TO SET UP A THREATENING ACTION AGAINST THE MOB AND POLITICAL VANGUARDS I AN OBJECT OF CHARGE, SUCH AS DEMONSTRATIONS, TAKE-OVERS AND LEAFLETS, THIS COMES ON THE ONE HAND TO TRIALS WITH SEVERAL YEAR SENTENCES AND ON THE OTHER HAND TO PROCEEDINGS WHICH HANG OVER THE ACTIVISTS UNDER THE THREAT OF WARRANTS OF ARREST THAT CAN BE ISSUED AT ANY MOMENT. THE PO-LITICAL INTIMIDATION IS NOT ONLY ADDRESSED AGAINST THE ACTIVISTS ALLA THE MORE INVOLVED IN POLITICS, BUT ALSO AGAINST THOSE INTELLECTUAL WHO AL-THOUGH THEY SHARE ONLY PARTIALLY A CERTAIN POLITICAL LINE INTEND TO GI-VE THE REVOLUTIONARY LEFT THE POSSIBILITY OF EXPRESSING ITSELF BY CONSEN-TING TO BE EDITORS OF ITS NEWSPAPERS. A PROCESS OF SOCIAL STRAIN AND BAT-TLES WHICH TOOK PLACE IN 1967 AND ESPECIALLY IN 1968 BROUGHT THE WASTING AWAY OF THE GOVERNING ALLIANCE BETWEEN SOCIALISTS AND CHRISTIAN DEMO-CRATS, SO THAT CAPITALISM NEEDED TO FIND A NEW EQUILIBRIUM OF POWERS TO BACK UP ITS NEW INTERESTS AS INSTRUMENTS OF CONTROL OVER THE SOCIETY ON ONE SIDE AND SUPPORT OF ITS IMPERIALISTIC EXPANSION ON THE OTHER. RAISES IN SALARY, OPENINGS TO TRADE-UNIONS, A WINDING-UP OF THE MOST BACKWARD SECTORS OF THE CONFINDUSTRIA (UNION OF EMPLOYERS), AN ADVANCED POLICY OF PENETRATION ON THE INTERNATIONAL MARKET AND PROJECTS OF RATIONALIZ-ING "REFORMS" FOSTERED A NEW OPENING TO THE LEFT AT A POLITICAL LEVEL.IT WAS THE POWER OF CLASS INITIATIVES THAT CAUSED THIS PLAN TO FALL THROUGH. FROM THE EPISODE OF THE THE BOMBS EXPLODED IN MILAN ON, THE FASCIST TER-RORISM AND THE SOCIALDEMOCRATIC PROVOCATION FROM INSTRUMENTS OF BLACK














MAILING AND PRESSURE TO ACHIEVE THE DEFEAT OF THE WORKING-CLASS CHANG-ED GRADUALLY INTO THE WINNING FRONT INSIDE THE BOURGEOIS BLOCK. CONTINUITY, THE EXTENT AND THE POWER OF CLASS WARFARE DISHEARTENED THE DREAM OF A REFORMATIVE INTEGRATION. THE RECRUDESCENCE OF THE STATE RE-PRESSION KEPT UP WITH THE FAILURE OF THE REFORM PLAN WHICH SHOULD HAVE BEEN CARRIED ON BY THE GOVERNMENT LED BY P.M. MR. COLOMBO. THE PLAN WAS CLEAR: AS SOON AS CONTRACTS WERE MADE THE QUESTION WAS TO COME TO A DECISIVE PERIOD OF INCREASE OF PRODUCTION BASED ON THE INTENSIFICATION OF WORK TIMES AND THE ELIMINATION OF THE BIGGEST ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL DI-SCREPANCIES. THE REFORM PLAN CAME TO NOTHING BECAUSE THE BASAL PRESUP-POSITION WAS MISSING: THAT THE WORKING-CLASS BATTLES, AS THE BOURGEOIS AND THE REFORMISTS WISHED, AFTER THE "HOT" AUTUMN (ACTIVE) WOULD COME DOWN TO SIMPLE NEGOTIATIONS OVER THE WAY OF APPLYING THE COLLECTIVE CONTRACTS. ON THE CONTRARY THEY RE-PROPOSED THE ESSENTIAL POINTS OF EX-PLOITATION AND TOOK UP A POSITION AGAINST JOB-WORK TIMES AND THE DIVI-SION OF QUALIFICATIONS, SWEEPING AWAY THE DREAM OF THOSE WHO DECEIVED THEMSELVES THAT WE WERE GETTING TO A PERIOD OF PRODUCTION RECOVERY AND CAPITALISTIC RE-ORGANIZATION BASED ON SOCIAL PEACE. IN VIEW OF THIS SITUATION THE CHANCES OF STRUGGLE GIVEN BY THE POLICY OF ORGANIZING THE TRADITIONAL LEFT SHOW THEIR INADEQUACY FOR THEY ARE INSIDE AN INSTITUTIO-NAL SYSTEM WHICH THE BOURGEOISIE AS PROGRESSIVELY DEPRIVED AND NOW THEY HAVE NO POSSIBLE ALTERNATIVE USE IN COMPARISON WITH THE ANTI-WORKING-CLASS ONE. THE ONLY SOLUTION IS TO GET INVOLVED IN THE CLASS WARFARE STAR-TING A BIG FRONT OF MOBILIZATION AGAINST REPRESSION AND FOR THE DEFENSE AND THE ENLARGEMENT OF THE POLITICAL SPACE WON BY THE MASS MOVEMENT.















...."IN THE FACTORIES AS ANYWHERE ELSE OWNERS KEEP PROLETARIANS SEPARATED TO ENFORCE THEIR POWER. THE CAPITALISTIC FACTORIES ARE EASILY RUN AS LONG AS EVERYONE WORKS ON HIS OWN AND REMAINS ISOLATED FROM THE OTHERS AND AS LONG AS EVERYONE SELLS HIS WORK ON THE OWNERS' CONDITIONSAS SOON AS WORKERS STOP LETTING THEMSELVES BE TREATED LIKE THINGS AND THEIR NEEDS AND INTERESTS BEGIN TO BE IMPORTANT AND INFLUENCE THEIR EFFORTS TO CREATE LINK-UP BETWEEN EACH INDIVIDUAL WORKER AND THE BASIS OF CLASS-SOLIDARITY, THEN THE MECHANISM OF PRODUCTION JAMS AND THERE IS CHAOS IN THE FACTORIES, THIS IS EXACTLY WHAT HAPPENED. FOR MANY YEARS OWNERS HAVE BUILT UP THEIR ABSOLUTE POWER IN THE FACTORIES BY REPRESSI-




VE MEASURES, SUCH AS POLITICAL DISMISSALS, TRANSFERS TO OTHER DEPARTMENTS, THE NEUTRALIZATION OF COMMUNIST ORGANIZATIONS FOR THE WORKING-CLASS (THE YELLOW TRADE-UNIONS), BLACKMAIL AND THE ALLUREMENT OF ANTI-STRIKE REWARDS AND OF RAISES IN SALARY ACCORDING TO THEIR JUDGEMENTS, THE DIVISION OF CATEGORIES ETC., UNTIL WORKERS STARTED THE STRUGGLE A-GAIN AND EVENTUALLY PUT THEIR OWN CLASS INTERESTS IN THE FIRST PLACE. SO THEY WOULD NO LONGER SELL THEIR WORK IN THE FACTORIES ON OWNERS. CONDITIONS BUT IMPOSED THEIR CONDITIONS, BY ATTACKING VIGOROUSLY THE INSTRUMENTS OWNERS MAKE USE OF TO DIVIDE AND EXPLOIT WORKERS: WITH DIFFERENCES IN SALARY, INCENTIVES, THE HIERARCHY OF JOBS, WORK-TIMES, THE OBJECTIVITY OF THE PRODUCTIVE CYCLE. SO IN THE COURSE OF THE STRUGGLE FACTORIES BECAME PLACES UTILIZABLE NOT ONLY BY OWNERS BUT ALSO BY WORKERS: NIZE THEIR CLASS SOLIDARITY. WORKERS TOOK OVER THE FACTORIES TO ASSERT THEIR INTERESTS AND THEIR POWER AND TO MAKE THEM A BASIS FOR GENERAL ATTACK AGAINST THE POWER BLOCK OF OWNERS.

"FOR YEARS IN THE FACTORIES THE WORKERS MADE THEIR MOVEMENTS IN THE WAY AND THE TIME OF THE PRODUCTION PLAN. THEY COME, TAKE THEIR PLACES IN THEIR SQUARES LIKE PUPPETS AND WORK, THEN GO OUT OF THE GATES AND DISPERSE IN EVERY DIRECTION. EVENTUALLY IN SPRING 1968 WE BEGAN TO DISCUSS ABOUT THE WAY OWNERS USED TO REGULATE THE TIME AND THE QUANTITY OF PRODUCTION. WE CLAIMED THE WORKERS' RIGHT TO BE INFORMED ABOUT TIMING AND SET OUR NECESSITY FOR PSYCHOPHYSICAL RECOVERY AGAINST THE INVIOLABILITY OF THE PRODUCTION TIMES. THAT WAS THE FIRST STEP. IN MAY 1969 THE STRUGGLE STARTED OVER AGAIN. SO THEY STARTED A NEW KIND OF STRIKE COLLECTIVELY DECIDED INSIDE THE DEPARTMENTS IN MEETINGS ACTUALLY WRUNG FROM OWNERS. IT WAS A KIND OF STRIKE WHICH ENLARGED THE ORGANIZATION OF WORKERS BECAUSE IT GAVE THEM THE POSSIBILITY OF STOPPING IN THE FACTORIES AND DISCUSSING TOGETHER ABOUT THE BEST WAY OF LEADING THE STRUGGLE. WORKERS BEGAN TO ACT CONSCIOUSLY, BROKE OWNERS' IMPOSITIONS AND CHANGED THE LINE OF CONDUCT IMPOSED ON THEM IN THE FACTORIES AND OUTSIDE. IT WAS CLEAR THAT IT IS POSSIBLE TO REMAIN SEPARATED EVEN IN THE STRUGGLE WHEN ITS METHOD IS WRONG. THE STRUGGLE AT DIFFERENT STAGES (FIRST BUILDING-WORKERS, METAL-WORKERS AND THEN TEXTILE-WORKERS, ETC.); OR EVEN THE STRUGGLE WHICH IS BEING EXTENDED TO THE FACTORY FLOORS FOR SEPARA-

TE CLAIMS, ON THE QUESTION OF DISCRIMINATION BETWEEN THE NATIONAL CONTRACT AND LATERA!. AGREEMENTS PREVENTS WORKERS FROM USING ALL THEIR POTENTIAL POWER IN THE BATTLE AGAINST OWNERS AND PERMITS THEM TO GET A NEW EQUILIBRIUM OF FORCES FROM THE PREVIOUS ONE, NOT TO ORGANIZE THE SEPARATED CLASS. WE UNIFIED OUR AIMS REALIZING THAT PRODUCTIVENESS IS NOT A PROBLEM OF OUR CLASS AND DOES NOT CONCERN WORKERS WHO MUST MAKE THEIR CLAIMS IN CONFORMITY WITH THEIR NEEDS". "STOP SWINDLING US WITH THE DIFFERENCES OF SALARY AND THE DIFFERENCES OF CATEGORIES (5 CATEGORIES BETWEEN LABOURERS AND EMPLOYEES), WITH THE RAISES NOT IN OUR SALARIES BUT IN OUR PRODUCTION PREMIUMS AND IN THE PLACE-WAGES. WE BASED OUR POWER AND OUR UNITY ON EQUALITY". WE PRACTISED SELF-DEFENCE DAY BY DAY TO PREVENT ORDER FROM BEING RESTORED IN THE FACTORIES. WE TOOK CONTROL OF THE MANAGEMENT OF THE STRUGGLE IN TOWN (LONGER BREAKS E-SPECIALLY IN UNHEALTHY PLACES, SLOWING-DOWN OF PRODUCTION, REFUSAL OF OVERTIME WORK, TEN MINUTE BREAKS EVERY TWO HOURS, THE LUNCH INTERVAL AND ALL THE TIME AVAILABLE TO DISCUSS AND TO ORGANIZE THE UNIFICATION OF THE BATTLES IN MEETINGS INSIDE THE FACTORIES AND OUTSIDE). WE PRACTISED COLLECTIVE INSUBORDINATION AGAINST THE LEGAL SYSTEM AND THE IMPOSITIONS IN THE FACTORIES. WE ALSO REJECTED THE DIVISION BETWEEN INSIDE AND OUTSIDE THE FACTORIES. WE ALSO REJECTED THE DIVISION BETWEEN INSIDE AND OUTSIDE THE FACTORIES WE WERE NOT "CITIZENS" BECAUSE WE WOULD NOT CEASE BEING ACTIVE WORKERS WHO MET WORKERS OF THEIR STRUGGLE TO THE STREETS, TO THE AREAS, TO THE SCHOOLS TO ORGANIZE THEIR POLITICAL PRESENCE INSIDE THE FACTORIES AND OUTSIDE IN THE AREAS OF TOWNS.


SO WE ATTENDED THE MEETINGS IN THE DORMITORY-AREAS TO TAKE OUR ACTIVE EXPERIENCE TO THE OTHER PLANTS AND TO THE OTHER FACTORIES IN THE SUBURBS. WE ORGANIZED OURSELVES SO AS NOT TO PAY RENTS AND TRANSPORT FARES AND TO RESIST EVICTIONS. AT NICHELINO, A DORMITORY-AREA FOR WORKERS ON THE FRINGE OF TURIN, FOR INSTANCE, WHERE THE TOWN HALL HAD BEEN TAKEN OVER BY WORKERS AND STUDENTS (AT THE REQUEST OF 'STOP EVICTION, HIGHER SALARIES FOR LOWER RENTS'), EVERY DAY NEWSPAPERS STUCK ON THE WALLS IN THE TOWN HALL YARD ILLUSTRATED THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE ACTION AND RAISED A DISCUSSION AT THE TOWN HALL SQUATTED IN BY THE PEOPLE. AN ORGANIZATION FOR DEBATES BETWEEN WORKING STUDENTS WAS SET UP AT THE UNIVER-




SITY, AND IN RENTED PREMISES NEAR THE PLANTS. EVERY DAY AT THE END OF THE TURNS WORKERS ORGANIZED LEAFLET DISTRIBUTIONS AND LINK-UPS BETWEEN THE PLANTS AND THE FACTORY DEPARTMENTS WITH A DAILY PAPER. COMING OUT OF FACTORIES TO POUR INTO CITY DEMONSTRATIONS WAS A WAY OF RECEIVING EXCHANGING-INFORMATION TO BREAK THE ISOLATION OF THE STRUGGLE IN RESPECT OF THE SOCIAL STRUCTURE OF THE CITY. THE WORKERS OF THE SUBURBAN AREAS WENT IN PROCESSION TO CONTEST THE CONSUMER FESTIVALS (DEMONSTRA TION AND PICKETING IN FRONT OF THE MOTOR SHOW HALL) AND USED THE METHO-DS THEY WERE GIVEN BY TRADE-UNION TRADITION TO ORGANIZE AND UNIFY THEIR GROUPS. 'YES' TO THE UNITY OF ALL WORKERS WITH THE SAME OBJECTIVES, 'NO' TO THE TRUCE BETWEEN NEGOTIATIONS, 'YES' TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE STRUGGLE AT ANY GIVEN MOMENT, 'NO' TO THE EXTERNAL SYMBOLIC BATTLE, 'YES' TO THE INTERNAL BATTLE WHICH STOPS PRODUCTION. 'NO' TO THE SYMBOLIC STRI-KES FOR REFORMS, 'YES' TO THE EXTENSION OF THE STRUGGLE FROM FACTORIES TO WHOLE TOWNS. 'NO' TO AN ORGANIZATION NEGOTIATED WITH THE OWNERS, YES' TO AN AUTONOMOUS ORGANIZATION OF WORKERS IN THE FACTORIES. IT WAS AGAINST THIS SITUATION WHICH AFFECTED THE INTERESTS AND THE CAPITALISTIC LEGAL SYSTEM THAT OWNERS SET THEMSELVES. THROUGH THIS SITUAT ION WHICH BROUGHT ABOUT THE REGROUPING OF THE WORKING-CLASS, REPRES-SION WAS ELIMINATED AND THE SPACES SO OBTAINED WERE CLOSED. AT THE SAME TIME THERE WAS AN ATTEMPT TO CARRY OUT THE STRATEGY OF CONSENT. WE MUST RESIST A PRODUCTION INCREASE AND A DISCIPLINE REVIVAL AND STRENGT-HEN THE ORGANIZATION.

IN ORDER TO IMPROVE WORK RELATIONS IN THE FACTORIES THE ACTIVE WORKERS ALSO MUST OPPOSE THE DIVISION OF PROLETARIANS IN THE SOCIETY AND THE INSTRUMENTS OWNERS POSSESS TO UNDO THEIR SALARY ACHIEVEMENTS AND TO BLACKMAIL THEIR ORGANIZATIONS, SUCH AS RISE OF PRICES AND UNEMPLOYMENT. THEY MUST CONTINUE LINKING TOGETHER THE WORKERS WHO ARE DISPERSED IN THE AREAS AND VILLAGES AFTER WORK AND THOSE WHO ARE ISOLATED IN SMALL FIRMS. THEY MUST INTENSIFY A POLITICAL WORK WITH THE OTHER SOCIAL GROUPS (EMPLOY EES, TECHNICISTS, STUDENTS, ETC.) SO THAT THESE GROUPS IN THEIR BATTLES MAY TAKE UP VIEWS AND METHODS FROM WORKERS. THEY MUST DEAL WITH THE TOTALITY OF THE PROBLEMS OF THE WORKING-CLASS SOCIAL STATUS (COST OF LIVING, UNEMPLOYMENT, HOUSING, SCHOOLING, HEALTH, ETC.) TO ORGANIZE A POPULAR BATTLE WITH DOCUMENTS AND LEAFLETS.








A STRONG ATTEMPT TO RESTORE ORDER IN SCHOOLS THROUGH A PROGRESSIVE CANCELLATION OF THE POLITICAL SPACE THAT STUDENT COLLECTIVELY WON DURING THESE ACTIVE YEARS (THE SCHOOL AUTHORITIES FORBID MEETINGS, ENFORCE DISCIPLINE, PURSUE THE VANGUARDS, REPRESS THE POLITICAL ACTIVITIES, ETC.) AND THROUGH THE RECOGNITION OF A SPACE INSTEAD WHICH MAY BREAK THE ANTIAUTHORITATIVE AND CULTURAL STIMULI IN THE SCHOOL SYSTEM AND DIDACTICS, WHERE STUDY AND MUTUAL MANAGEMENT MAY BECOME THE ALTERNATIVE TO THE STRUGGLE AND THE SOCIAL BEHAVIOR, IS BEING









UNDER THE STIMULUS OF THE WORKING-CLASS BATTLES AND IN REFERENCE TO THE PRACTICAL DISCUSSION WHICH THEY WERE LEADING TO A SOCIAL DIVISION AND STRATIFICATION, THE MAJORITY OF THE STUDENTS WAS AVAILABLE TO TURN THEIR REFUSAL OF DISCIPLINE AND THEIR INDIFFERENCE TOWARDS THE SO-CALLED CULTURE INTO INSUBORDINATION AGAINST THE PRODUCTION SYSTEM AND THE SOCIAL STRATIFICATION.

ACTUALLY THE STRUGGLE WAS AGAINST THE SCHOOL AND ITS CULTURE AS AN INSTRUMENT OF DIVISION IN FAVOR OF THE UNIFICATION OF THE WORKING STUDENTS: IT STARTED WITH SIT-IN DEMONSTRATIONS IN THE TOWNS, THEN WITH THE TAKING OVER OF SCHOOLS WHICH WERE TURNED INTO CENTERS OP PROPAGANDA AND POLITICAL DEBATES OPEN TO ALL THE ACTIVISTS. YET AT TIMES THE INDIFFERENCE OF THE PEOPLE TOWARDS THE PROBLEM OF SCHOOLING BECAME INDIFFERENCE TOWARDS THE ORGANIZATION AND THE POLITICAL PRESENCE INSIDE THE SCHOOL. THEREFORE THE NEED OF A GLOBAL ALTERNATIVE TO MORALS AND CULTURE, I.E. THE BOURGEOIS RULES, FLEW INTO THE PERSONAL (OR INTER-PERSONAL) PRACTICE OF ILLEGALITY (THE JUVENILE DELINQUENCY, THE EXALTATION OF DRUG, THE IDEOLOGY OF COMMUNES, POP FESTIVALS, ETC.). THIS KIND OF CHOICE IS SECONDARY AND INADEQUATE BECAUSE IT DOES NOT PREVENT PEOPLE FROM. BEING EXPLOITED AND HAS NO CONNECTION WITH PROLETARIAN STRUGGLE AGAINST THE CAPITALISTIC EXPLOITATION. NOW OUR PROBLEM IS TO MAKE THE PRESENCE OF THE VANGUARDS PERMANENT IN THE MASS OF STUDENTS TO OPEN A NEW PROSPECT OF BEHAVIOR IN THE SCHOOL FOR A NEW USE OF CULTURE (THE POLITICAL USE OF THE SCHOOL) WHICH MAY BE CONNECTED WITH THE CLASS EXIGENCES AND THE OBJECTIVES OF THE PROLETARIAN STRUGGLE.

"LET US START FROM THOSE CONTRADICTIONS WHICH ARE IN THE MASS OF STUDENTS AND YET OPEN PROSPECTS OF LINK-UPS WITH THE PROLETA-RIANS" (THE STRUGGLE AGAINST COSTS AND SELECTION, DIRECT AND ILLE-GAL TAKE-OVERS) "EMANCIPATION CANNOT TAKE PLACE IN THE SCHOOL, BUT ONLY THROUGH THE STRUGGLE AND THE PROCESS OF THE EMANCIPATION OF PROLETARIANS"

....THE GOVERNMENT MUST CARRY OUT A POLICY OF REFORMS. WE WE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE DEMOCRATIC PARTIES WITH RESPONSABILITY OF MANAGEMENT ON DIFFERENT LEVELS MUST PUT PRESURE ON THE PARLIAMENT TO HAVE NEW BILLS INTRODUCED AND MEASURES TAKEN IN THIS DIRECTION. IT IS OBVIOUS THAT A DEVELOPMENT OF OUR NATIONAL ECONOMY AND AN INCREASE OF

PRODUCTION WILL NOT OCCUR UNTIL THE STANDARD OF LIV-ING OF OUR COUNTRY IS NOT IMPROVED. 



OUR CHILDREN NEED TO PLAY IN THE OPEN AIR: LET US TAKE OVER PARKS AND GARDENS. BUSTLING IS NOT SUFFICIENT. WE MUST HAVE SOCIAL EXPERIENCES IN THE FACTORIES AS WELL AS IN TOWN. THE "INTERMEDIATE CITY"

WITH ITS SPACES, STRUCTURES, STREETS, HOUSES, THE CITY IS A PHYSICAL REALITY WHEREIN OUR ACTIONS ARE CREATED; IT IS A MASS OF INSTRUMENTS WHENCE WE TAKE THE MATERIAL TO REALIZE OUR INTERVENTIONS. PHYSICAL, SCIENTIFIC, IDEOLOGIC MATERIAL, INFORMATION, LANGUAGE; ALL ARE PRESENT IN THE COMPLEX WEB OF TOWN RELATIONS AND ALL MUST BE AN OCCASION TO BRING FORWARD THE GENERAL STRUGGLE WHOSE OBJECTIVE IS TO GIVE POWER TO PROLETARIANS.

"THE INTERMEDIATE CITY" IS THE COMBINATION OF THE POLITICAL BEHAVIORS IN THIS PROCESS AND IS REPRESENTED BY THEIR FORMALIZATION. THROUGH THE "INTERMEDIATE CITY" WE MUST DEFEND OURSELVES FROM REPRESSION.

THE CAPITALIST CANNOT BEAR THE FORMING OF BEHAVIORS, SPACES AND CONDITIONS OPPOSED TO HIS INTERESTS IN HIS OWN CITY (THE CITY OF CAPITAL). THE BOUR GEOIS INSTITUTIONS (INCLUDING PARLIAMENT AND POLICE FORCES) ARE DELEGATED TO CONTROL, TO STOP AND TO BREAK UP ALL THE INITIATIVES OPPOSED TO THE ESTABLISHED INTERESTS. AGAINST THESE FORCES AND THE CONSTANT ATTEMPT TO REDUCE THE PRACTICABILITY OF THE CITY, WE MUST SET A COLLECTIVE ORGANIZATION WHICH SUPPORT THE PROLETARIAN STRUGGLE IN THE FACTORIES, IN THE AREAS; IN THE COUNTRY.

RULES, GRANTS AND LAWS INTRODUCED AD THE RESULT OF AN OBJECTIVE HISTORICAL PROCESS BECOME AN INSTRUMENT OF REPRESSION IN THE HANDS OF THE CAPITALIST WHO AVAILS HIMSELF OF HIS PRIVILEGED STANDING.

THE "INTERMEDIATE CITY" FIGHTS AGAINST THE CAPITALISTIC ILLEGALITY AND PROPOSES A KIND OF LEGALITY BASED ON THE PROLETARIAN JUSTICE ACCORDING TO VALUES WHICH COME FROM THE EMANCIPATION OF PROLETARIANS. WE CAN ORGANIZE OUR PRESENT THROUGH THE "INTERMEDIATE CITY". DURING THE BATTLES IN THE LAST YEARS, WITH THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE PROCESS OF UNIFICATION ON A SOCIAL LEVEL, ALSO THE RANGE OF ANTAGONISTIC BEHAVIORS WHICH IS ANOMALOUS IN CONNECTION WITH THE MYSTIFYING LOGIC OF THE MANAGEMENT OF THE CITY HAS SPREAD OUT. THE CITY PLACES WHERE EXPLOITATION AND REPRESSION ARE GREATER (FACTORIES, AREAS, STREETS, MARKETS, PRISONS, HOSP (TALS, SCHOOLS, ETC.) HAVE BECOME THE PLACES WHERE THE CITY SOCIAL HIERARCHY IS CENSURED. THE POLITICAL USE OF PROLETARIANS HAS TWISTED THE ORIGINAL DESTINATION OF THOSE PLACES AND HAS OFTEN CONSOLIDATED IN NEW ORGANIZATIONS. IN THE GHETTO-AREAS WHERE THE INHABITANTS STIKE FOR RENTS AND RESIST EVICTIONS, THE SOCIAL CENTERS, THE SCHOOLS, THE CHURCHES HAVE BEEN TAKEN OVER AND CHANGED INTO CENTERS OF DISCUSSION AND POLITICAL ORGANIZATION: WHERE THERE WERE NO PREMISES TO SQUAT IN THE PEOPLE BUILT THEM UP AFTER TAKING OVER OPEN GROUNDS. THEY USED THEIR SPARE TIME, EVENINGS AND WEEKENDS FOR POLITICAL MEETINGS FOR THE CO-ORDINATION BETWEEN BLOCKS AND AREAS AND FOR ORGANIZING THE DEMONSTRATIONS IN TOWN, SHOWS AND OTHER ACTIVITIES OF COUNTERS OF ACTORS AND CINEMATOGRAPHERS (MILITANT CINEMA COLLECTIVE, PROLETARIAN SONG-BOOK, ETC.).

IN THE SQUATTED HOUSES THE FAMILIES TRY TO ORGANIZE CONSCIOUSLY A COMMUNIST WAY OF LIVING; COLLECTIVE CANTEENS, NURSERY SCHOOLS, FIRST AID CENTERS AND PERIODIC MEETINGS ARE REAL ACHIEVEMENTS OF THE STRUGGLE, DURING THE BATTLES THE ATTACK OF WORKERS AND PROLETARIANS ON THE CITY HAS OFTEN PROFANED THE INSTITUTIONAL TEMPLES OF THE URBAN MANAGEMENT, OF CULTURE, OF INFORMATION AND OF CONSUMPTION. PROCESSIONS, GENERAL MEETINGS, DISTRIBUTIONS OF LEAFLETS, DEMONSTRATIONS IN THE BIG STORES AND ON BUSES AND TROLLEYS, WALL INSCRIPTIONS, INITIATIVES OF COUNTER-INFORMATION, PAPERS, POSTERS, PERMANENT PICKETINGS IN PUBLIC PLACES, TEMPORARY STREET BLOCKS, ETC. ARE THE RIGHT ACTIONS WHICH BY OPPOSING THE CAPITALISTIC REPRESSION CREATE THE "INTERMEDIATE OUR NON' FOR A PROLETARIAN POSSESSION OF THE CITY, THE "INTERMEDIATE

AS ACTIVISTS AND TECHNICIANS WE INTEND TO BE PRESENT WITH OUR KNOW-LEDGE TO TAKE PART IN THE BUILDING UP TO THE "INTERMEDIATE CITY". REA-DY TO' SATISFY THE NEEDS OF THE STRUGGLE AND TO SUGGEST WHICH MEANS AND BEHAVIORS SEEM TO BE MORE SUITABLE TO THE SITUATION.

IN THIS PROGRAM OF ACTION THE RELATIONS WITH THE INSTITUTIONS OF THE ESTABLISHED SOCIAL SYSTEM CANNOT BE EITHER OF DIALOGUE OR OF DISCUSSION, BUT ONLY A BATTLE FOR GAINING POWER, FOR WRINGING SPACES OF INTERVENTION, FOR RECOVERING INSTRUMENTS, FOR DIVULGING THE ONLY EFFECTIVE LANGUAGE CO-ORDINATED WITH THE MOBILIZATION OF THE MASS, NO DIALOGUE, BUT CHALLE NGE TO THE ESTABLISHED INSTITUTIONS, TAKING ADVANTATION OF THE DISCREPANCIES THAT THE IDEOLOGY OF THE PREVAILING CLASS CANNOT CONCEAL.

THIS CONSTANT ADHERENCE TO THE MOBILIZATION WITH ACTIONS OF PROPAGANDA DOES NOT EXCLUDE A DEVELOPMENT AND A DEEPENING OF THE POSSIBILITY OF ELABORATING OUR RELATIONSHIP WITH THE CITY, IF WE MEAN BY DEEPENING THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN EACH INTERVENTION, NAMELY THE COMPARISON OF THE VARIOUS SITUATIONS WITH THE ANALOGOUS ONES IN THE PAST,

THE WHOLE OF THE POLITICAL ANTI-CAPITALISTIC BEHAVIORS, THEIR ROOTING IN THE COUNTRY, THE WEB OF THEIR CONNECTIONS, THEIR FORMALIZATION IN THE RELATIONSHIP OBJECT-SYMBOL, MAKE THE "INTERMEDIATE CITY" WITH A CONTINUOUS PROCESS DIRECTED TO THE BUILDING UP OF COMMUNISM. WE CAN ALSO SPEAK OF PREFIGURATION OF A FUTURE CITY AS A FACT INSIDE OF THIS PROCESS AND AS AN IMAGINARY ANTICIPATION ON THE POSSIBLE DEVELOPMENT OF SOME FUNCTIONS BESIDES THE PRESENT ORGANIZING CAPACITIES. FOR THIS REASON THE "INTERMEDIATE CITY" MAKES USE OF UTOPIA, TOO, AS AN INSTRUMENT OF INTERVENTION AND AS AN OPERATION CONTROLLED BY A GLOBAL RELATIONSHIP WITH THE REALITY WHICH, GETTING OVER THE SUBJECTIVE MOMENT, RE-ESTABLISH THE COMPARISON WITH THE REAL EXPERIENCE OF THE STRUGGLE.

THE CITY OF CAPITALISTS MAKES ITSELF KNOWN, CONSTANTLY INFORMS OF ITS CONSISTENCE THROUGH ITS SERVICES, ITS COSTS, ITS VALUES WHICH IT PURSUES. THE TECHNOLOGICAL DEVELOPMENT OF THE SIGHT-ANDSOUND MEANS GIVES RISE TO A GREATER AND GREATER SELF-FLATTERING THROUGH WHICH THE CITY CONSIDERS ITSELF A FULL PRODUCT CONTAINING THE POSSIBILITIES OF DEVELOPMENT AND CHANGE. THE MORE INFORMATION AS AN ADDRESS IMPOSED ON A PASSIVE AUDIENCE SPREADS OUT, THE GREATER THE ILLUSION OF PARTICIPATION IS. THE "INTERMEDIATE CITY" IS AGAINST THIS ABUSE AND PROMOTES THE CREATION OF ALTERNATIVE STRUCTURES OF COUNTER-INFORMATION TO DEMOLISH THE CAPITALISTIC IDEOLOGY, TO INFORM ABOUT THE STRUGGLES AND TO GIVE NEW INSTRUMENTS TO. THE PROLETARIAN CREATIVENESS.

THE "INTERMEDIATE CITY" IS PART OF A POLITICAL PROGRAM AND ONLY MAKES SENSE INSIDE OF IT. THE RECOVERY FROM THE PAST, THE USE OF THE PRESENT, THE CONTINUITY IN THE FUTURE REQUIRE THE CONSTANT PRESENCE OF A DEFINITE POLITICAL CO-ORDINATION AND A HYPOTHESIS OF GLOBAL STRATEGY, AS A MEANS OF VERIFICATION AND CONTROL. THIS ARRANGEMENT DETERMINES THE RANGE AND THE LIMIT OF ACTIONS WHICH GIVE THE POSSIBILITY OF FACTING THE POLITICAL PROBLEM OF WARFARE. BESIDES THE IDEOLOGY OF SCIENTIFIC CONGREGATIONS, IT IS NECESSARY TO CONFIRM THE EXIGENCE OF A NEW SPACE FOR THE BUILDING UP OF THE CITY DIFFERENT FROM THAT OF THE BUILDING SPECULATION AND DIFFERENT FROM THAT OF THE CLASSIC UTOPIAS WHICH WITH THEIR ABSURD TALKING, OFFER, SOONER OR LATER, NOTHING OTHER THAN NEW INDICATIONS FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE POLICY OF POWER.

NEW POLITICAL SPACES MUST BE CREATED AND DEFENDED THROUGH ACTIONS WHICH INVOLVE THE STRUCTURAL AND SUPERSTRUCTURAL CONSISTENCE OF THE VARIOUS ROLES AND WHICH. BY MAKING TECHNICIANS PROLETARIANS AND SPECIALIZING PROLETARIANS, OPEN A NEW WAY TO AN EFFECTIVE CLASS UNIFICATION. NOT ONLY FORMAL BUT ESSENTIAL, FULL OF CONTENTS, FOR A DIFFERENT CITY RESULTING FROM A CONTINUOUS REVOLUTIONARY PROCESS.

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
